Fairtrade Schools Award

- Free to register <u>schools.fairtrade.org.uk/</u>
- 3 award categories (Aware, Active, Achiever)
- No time limit
- Can be delegated to someone else in schools
- Can be used toward the Eco-Schools Award (as an international project)

Award Overview

It's still about learning, fun and action. It still puts young people at the centre. We've made changes to include:

- School audits
- Optional challenges
- Three awards to work towards

The first two awards are selfassessed, while FairAchiever will be assessed by our network of volunteer expert assessors around the UK. This means the Fairtrade Schools Award remains free of charge for schools.

Schools that have a current Fairtrade Schools Award will of course retain it and will have up to three years to renew it.

Do the Learner Audit and a Learning Challenge and your school will be ready to get its FairAware Award. Take on two more challenges with help from your school's Fairtrade Group and your school will be working towards its FairActive Award. Do three more challenges, and adopt a Fairtrade policy along with further learning activities, and your school will be getting ready for its final stage – assessment for the FairAchiever Award.

This Award is the equivalent of the current Fairtrade Schools Award.



FairAware Award



- Carry out a learner audit (at least 60 learners or the whole school if its smaller)
- Carry out the teacher audit
- Carry out a FairAware Learning Challenge



FairActive Award

- Set up a Fairtrade Group
- Hold an assembly
- Create an action plan
- Hold a fairtrade event
- Complete one other challenge
 - Make a Fairtrade Switch (canteen, catering)
 - Run a Campaign
 - Put on a Fairtrade Event
 - Fundraise for Fairtrade
 - Invite a speaker about Fairtrade
 - A School visit related to Fairtrade
 - Involve the Wider community or another school
 - Invent your own challenge!




- Adopt a Fairtrade policy


