

The Construction Industry

Economy

- Contributes £90b pa to the UK economy (UK Gov)
- Employees 2.9 million in the UK (UK Gov)
- Global construction output is forecast to increase from \$8.5 trillion today to \$12 trillion in 2025 (Global construction)

<u>Carbon</u>

- Energy used in construction and operation of homes and buildings -50% of the UK's total CO₂e emissions (UK GBC)
- 82% operational carbon 18% embodied carbon (Green Construction Board)
- 87% of existing buildings will be standing in 2050 (UK GBC)




